

MASK INFORMATION FOR SUPPLY LISTS

(partial section copied from St. John's COVID Preparedness Plan)

Face Coverings

Per Executive Order 20-81:

All students, staff, and other people present in school buildings and district offices or riding on school transportation vehicles are required to wear a face covering. Face coverings are meant to protect other people in case the wearer does not know they are infected. A face covering is not meant to substitute for social distancing, but is especially important in situations when maintaining a 6-foot distance is not possible.

- According to the MN Department of Health, “face coverings are generally required for all students, staff and other people present in any kindergarten through grade 12 school buildings or district offices or riding on school transportation vehicles. **To provide a consistent, safe environment for students and staff, this requirement applies equally to kindergarteners, even those aged 5 or under.**”
- Types of allowable face coverings include:
 - Paper or disposable mask
 - Cloth face mask
 - Scarf
 - Bandanna
 - Neck gaiter / buff
 - Religious face covering
- The covering should cover the nose and mouth completely, should not be overly tight or restrictive, and should feel comfortable to wear.

Exemption:

According to paragraph 8.a of Executive Order 20-81, **the following exemption is as follows:** “Individuals with a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability that makes it unreasonable for the individual to maintain a face covering. This includes, but is not limited to, individuals who have a medical condition that compromises their ability to breathe, and individuals who are unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove a face covering without assistance. These individuals should consider using alternatives to face coverings, including clear face shields, and staying home as much as possible.”

In general, unless the individual is exempt under paragraph 8.a (above) of Executive Order or is under the age of two, all students, staff, and other persons present indoors in school buildings and district offices or riding on school transportation vehicles are required to wear a face covering.

Face Shield Allowance due to Exemption:

Students and staff have increased flexibility to wear face shields in certain circumstances. A face shield (a clear plastic barrier that covers the face) allows visibility of facial expressions and lip movements for speech perception. For optimal protection, the face shield should extend below the chin anteriorly, to the ears laterally, and there should be no exposed gap between the forehead and the shield's headpiece. **A face shield may be used as an alternative to a face covering in the following situations:**

- For students who are unable to tolerate a face covering due to a developmental, behavioral, or medical condition.
- For teachers of all grades when a face covering would impede the educational process.
- For staff providing direct support student services when a face covering would interfere with the services provided.
- For students in kindergarten through grade 8 when wearing a face covering is otherwise problematic for the student.

Kindergarten through grade 12 schools must comply with face covering and face shield guidance available at <https://www.health.state.mn.us/diseases/coronavirus/schools/k12planguide.pdf>.

St. John's Policy:

Students seeking exemption from wearing a face covering must have a note from a doctor (non-family member) to verify that they have a medical, developmental, or behavioral condition making them exempt. These students will wear face shields as an alternative (as described in the face shield section above) to a face covering.

For students in Kindergarten through 8th grade:

St. John's will give each student one cloth face mask once they are supplied by MDE.

Kindergarten through 4th Grades

More information to help select a protective case or sleeve for students in 1st through 4th grades who will carry Chromebooks® home daily. There is a wide assortment of cases or sleeves available on the market. They are made from a variety of materials and some have handles or pockets.

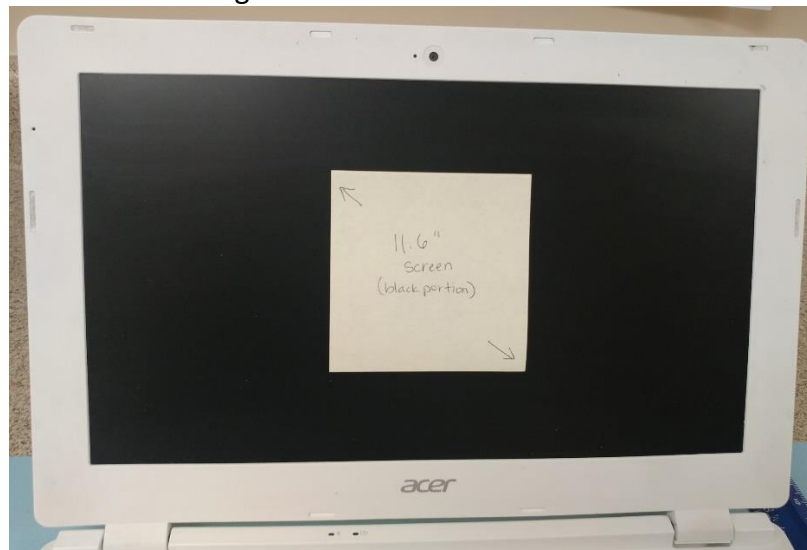
